

### Animated GIF files

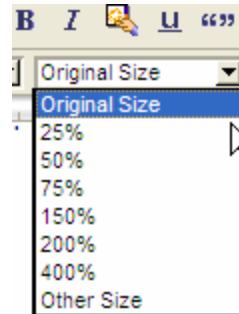
Many people enjoy using animated gif files in their web pages. For licensing reasons, the FirstClass client no longer includes a GIF plug-in so you will not be able to see your GIF file in the FirstClass Client. However, any animated GIF inserted in to your home page documents will be displayed properly in a web browser.

1. Find a copyright free animated GIF
2. If it is on the Internet, Right click it and Select "Save Picture As"
3. Navigate the **Desktop** or **My Pictures** folder and save it.
4. Return to your HCK2 file
5. Click where you want the animated GIF to be inserted into your document and

choose **Insert**  -> **Image/File** and select the file from your computer. This will insert it to your home page and sometimes display it using a generic icon like this -



. You can view your page in a Web Browser, and if necessary, use the resizing and text wrapping features of the FirstClass Client accordingly clicking the image and adjusting the size.
