Burleson ISD surveyed parents and students to provide insight on which elementary schools of choice are most relevant to students' needs.

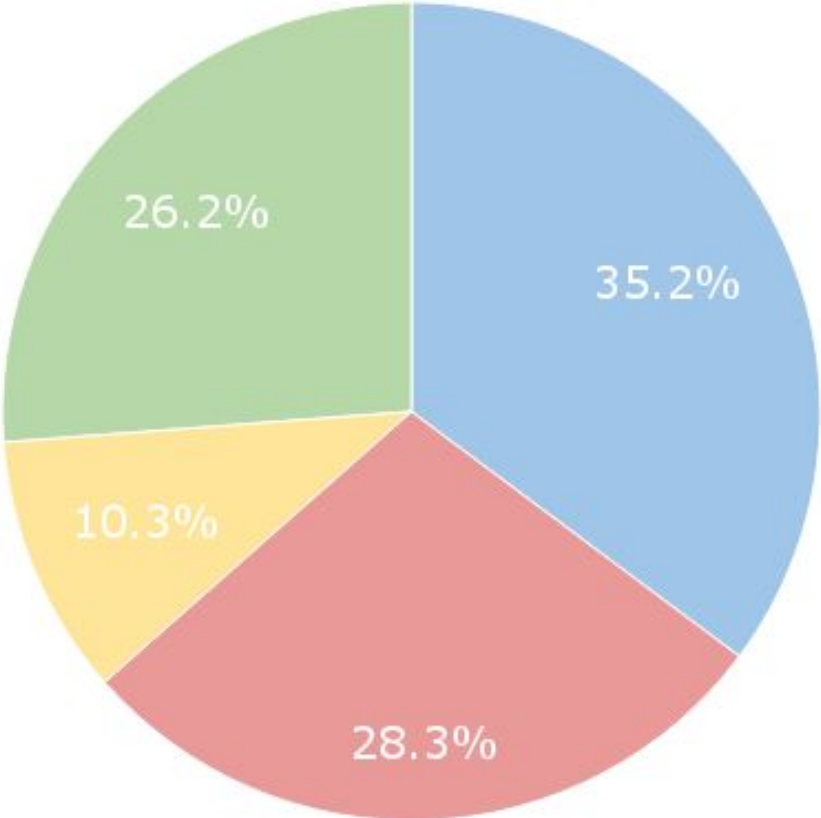

Language Academy - This school offers language electives that provide students with the opportunity to study a foreign language and the cultures of foreign countries. Core classes would be taught in English.

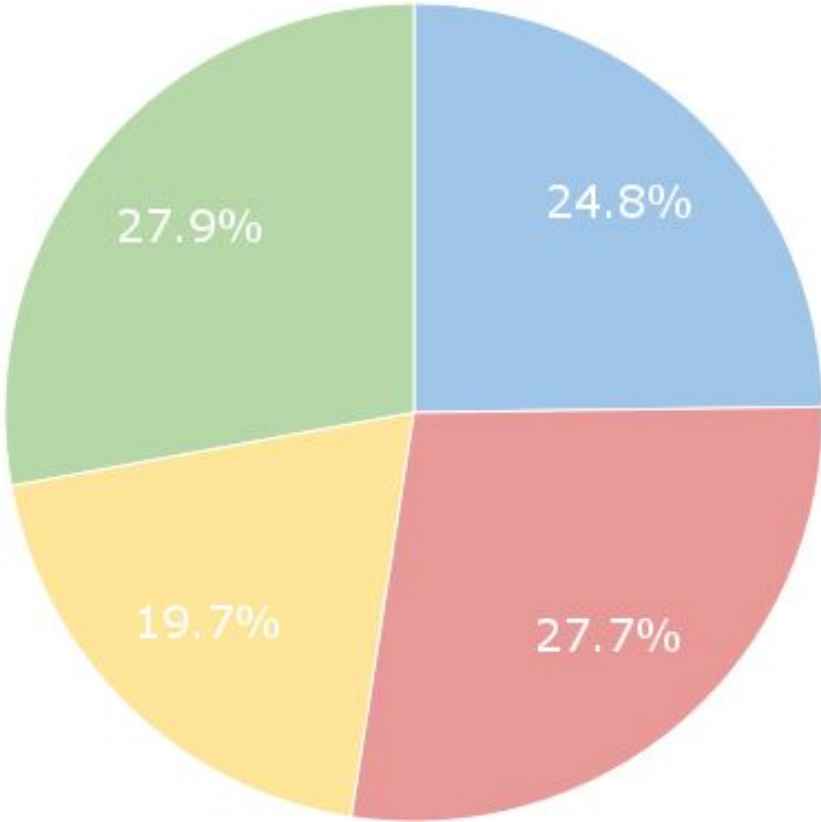

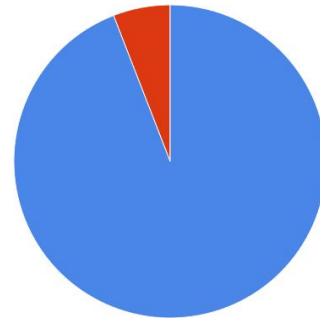

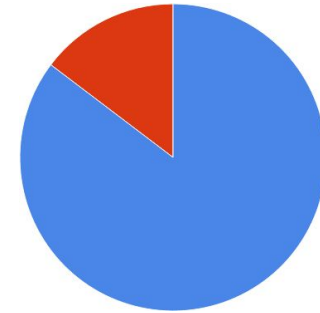
Key Information

If an elementary school in your neighborhood attendance zone offered one of your top choices, would you choose that school?



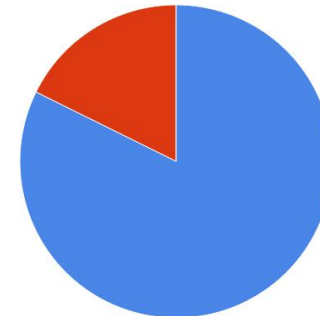
- Yes (94.1%)
