Industry Based Certifications

+Certified Patient Care Technician

A patient care technician provides care for patients such as bathing, eating, dressing & walking. They work closely with nurses & other medical staff and are often the ones with the most contact with patients.

+Emergency Medical Technician-Basic

This certification exam measures important competencies as part of a comprehensive EMS response system. The exam covers the entire spectrum of EMS care including: airway, respiratory & ventilation, cardiology & resuscitation, trauma, etc.

To earn a CTE endorsement, students must take a minimum of 3 classes for 4 or more credits in the same Program of Study, and must end with one Level 3 or Level 4 CTE course.
