BISD First Week - Elementary School

- August 31st is the first week of school
- If you chose Virtual Learning, your whole week will be virtual learning
- If you chose On-Campus, you will have a mix of Virtual and On-campus days, with full On-Campus learning beginning September 8th
 - This allows us to bring small groups of students in and practice protocols and procedures
 - More information on the Virtual schedules during these days will be coming
 - More information on providing Chromebooks for those who don't have them will be coming
 - Normal start and end times will take place on the days of On-campus
 - Normal busses will take place on the days of On-campus
 - Note: This is a normal school day, and the new policies and procedures for visitors, etc. will be followed

- Knowing that these grades may need more support with protocols and procedures, they are being asked to attend in person more frequently the week of August 31st.

Meet the Teacher

- Virtual Meetings will be set up by each classroom teacher for Thursday, 8/27/2020.
- Times will vary by each individual teacher.
- Families will be contacted and sent an invitation prior to this day.
- Each teacher will also send out a pre-recorded video introducing themselves and give a visual of how their classroom is set-up.



Arrival

- Staff will all wear mask and be on duty, ready for students beginning at 7:15 a.m. No entrance will open prior to 7:15, so please allow your student to remain in their vehicles until 7:15 am.
- All students ages 10 years and older will be required to wear a mask. Family members
 who walk students to the front should also be masked. Due to the number of students at
 arrival and dismissal, we ask that all students wear a mask at arrival and dismissal.
- Separate entrances will be utilized for car riders, bus riders, walkers and daycares as follows.

Arrival Continued

- All staff will be utilized for duty to maintain a line of sight in hallways and distancing of hallway cohorts.
- Students will go straight to the designated areas. For those that eat breakfast at school, they
 will receive a "grab and go" breakfast from the cafeteria and go to their designated area as
 follows:
- Pre K and Kindergarten
 - Kindergarten students will enter through the gym door where there teachers will be awaiting them.
- 1st-5th Grade
 - o straight to their classroom areas.
- Please send water bottles for your student that are labeled and full. Water fountains throughout the school will be turned off.
 - Teachers will provide them cups of water in case of an emergency.
- Students are also encouraged to bring healthy, nut-free snacks in their backpacks.

Dismissal

- It is very important that families are consistent with how a student goes home or gets picked-up each and every day to help our staff maintain the health and safety of all.
- In order to avoid large group gatherings there will NOT be a walk up option for parents to receive their students. The only options for parent pick up at this time is to wait in your vehicle until your student's name is called or to wait across the street until your child is walked across the street at the crosswalk on Oak Grove Rd.
- In order to maintain and monitor for social distancing, the areas explained below have been designated for students each afternoon.



Dismissal Continued

Areas for dismissal:

- Pre K and Kindergarten
 - Car Riders Gym Doors to Pick Up Lanes
- Bus and Daycare
 - Cafeteria Doors
- 1st-5th Car Riders
 - Dismissed from their classroom to the Front Door to the Pick Up Lanes
- All Walkers
 - Front Side Gate to Crosswalk on Oak Grove Rd.
- All students ages 10 years and older will be required to wear a mask. Family members who walk students to the front should also be masked. Due to the number of students at arrival and dismissal, we ask that all students wear a mask at arrival and dismissal.

Lunch

- Pre K- 2nd grade will eat in the cafeteria one grade-level at a time
 - We are able to set 4 students per round table.
- Tables will be properly sanitized between each lunch period.
- Students with food allergies will be at separate tables.
- 3rd-5th graders will eat in their classrooms
- Students who buy their lunch will be assisted by Cafeteria workers students with food choices to ensure minimal student contact.
- Staff members will monitor and assist students and ensure social distancing while in lines and at tables.
- In order to maintain the health and safety of students and staff, we are unable to allow lunch visitors at this time. As guidelines relax, we will be able to welcome visitors back for lunch.

Recess

- Students will either wash their hands or use hand sanitizer prior to playing on any outdoor equipment.
- Students will either wash their hands or use hand sanitizer after recess as they enter the building.
- Staff will be on duty to monitor for health and safety protocols.
- Classes from each grade-level will alternate daily between playing on the playground equipment, basketball court, and soccer field. All students will have recess.
- Playground equipment will be cleaned between each group of students.



Walking around the building

- Students will be encouraged to wear masks when walking around the building as individuals or as a member of a large group.
- Staff members will monitor for health and safety protocols.
- The hallway tiles will be used to guide students in how to social distance.
 - Each student will maintain a distance of 3 tile lengths to ensure social distancing.



Restrooms

- Teachers will have procedures in their classroom to ensure that only one student is out at a time for a restroom break.
- For whole group restroom breaks, grade levels and classrooms will stagger restroom times and monitor and ensure health and safety protocols are followed.
 - No more than 2 students in a restroom at one time.
 - No more than 1 student at a handwashing station at one time.
 - Social distancing will be marked on the floor for students.
