# BISD First Week - High School

- August 31st is the first week of school
- If you chose Virtual Learning, your whole week will be virtual learning
- If you chose On-Campus, you will have a mix of Virtual and On-campus days, with full On-Campus learning beginning September 8th
  - This allows us to bring small groups of students in and practice protocols and procedures
  - More information on the Virtual schedules during these days will be coming
  - More information on providing Chromebooks for those who don't have them will be coming
  - Normal start and end times will take place on the days of On-campus
  - Normal busses will take place on the days of On-campus
  - Note: This is a normal school day, and the new policies and procedures for visitors, etc. will be followed



# High School Schedule for BISD First Week

- Knowing that 9th grade may need more support with protocols and procedures, they are being asked to attend in person more frequently the week of August 31st.
- The schedule for On-Campus is as follows:

    - Virtual - Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
  - 10th Grade
    - On-campus - Tuesday
    - Virtual - Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday
  - 11th Grade
    - On-campus - Wednesday
    - Virtual - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
  - 12th Grade
    - On-campus - Thursday
    - Virtual - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday



# Meet the Teacher & 9th Grade College Acceptance Night

- Meet the Teacher (all grade levels)
  - Teachers will send out an introductory video (along with contact information and conference times) to all families by Aug. 28
  
- 9th Grade College Acceptance Night
  - TBD (We are hoping for September but this date is still being coordinated between Hill College and BISD. We will share details as soon as we have them.)



# Arrival

- **Student/Staff Entrance:**
    - When students enter for the day, students will go straight to 1st period or to the cafeteria to eat
    - Students and staff will use the BCHS main entrance
  - **Bus Riders**
    - Bus Riders will enter Bus Entrance at CHS and come directly to 1st period or the cafeteria
  - **Late Arrivals**
    - Students will check in through main entrance at the front of the campus

# Dismissal

- Students will exit the building using the BCHS entrance/exit
  - There will be staggered release for students to reduce the number of students exiting at one time
    - Shuttle Riders
    - Upstairs
    - Downstairs
    - Bus Riders
    - Staff will monitor students exiting the building at dismissal to minimize loitering
  - Students with “outs” will depart campus immediately through front entrances upon start of “Out Period”

# Lunch

- Tables spread out in cafeteria as well other locations in the building in order to maintain distancing
- Students will sit every other seat in order to account for spacing
- BCHS staff will monitor the various locations and ensure distancing during lunch

# Walking around the building

- Passing periods and transitions
  - Students will transition between all class periods
  - Staff will be monitoring during transitions for the correct flow of traffic
  - Students walk on the right side of each hallway, crossing over when at the classroom
  - Students will use the right side of the stairwell to maintain a flow of traffic
  - Students will not be permitted to stop in the hallways (lockers, congregating, etc) to allow for constant movement of traffic flow until the final destination is reached.
- Nurse Visit
  - Only students with designated passes will enter Centennial to visit the nurse
- Elevators
  - Only designated students will be allowed to use the elevators





# Restrooms

- Only one student per class can be gone at a time
- Students downstairs will use the downstairs restrooms, students upstairs will use the upstairs restrooms.
- Signs will be posted to encourage social distancing and proper handwashing
- Staff will monitor restrooms during passing periods for social distancing
