## Start of School Information for Frazier Elementary School

#### **BISD First Week - Elementary School**

- August 31st is the first week of school
- If you chose Virtual Learning, your whole week will be virtual learning
- If you chose On-Campus, you will have a mix of Virtual and On-campus days, with full On-Campus learning beginning September 8th
  - This allows us to bring small groups of students in and practice protocols and procedures
  - More information on the Virtual schedules during these days will be coming
  - More information on providing Chromebooks for those who don't have them will be coming
  - Normal start and end times will take place on the days of On-campus
  - Normal busses will take place on the days of On-campus
  - Note: This is a normal school day, and the new policies and procedures for visitors, etc. will be followed

#### **Elementary Early Childhood Schedule for BISD First Week**

- Knowing that these grades may need more support with protocols and procedures, they are being asked to attend in person more frequently the week of August 31st.
- The schedule for On-Campus is as follows:
  - Pre-K and Kinder
    - On -campus Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
    - Virtual Friday
  - 1st Grade
    - On- campus Monday, Friday
    - Virtual Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
  - 2nd Grade
    - On campus Tuesday, Friday
    - Virtual Monday, Wednesday, Thursday



#### **Elementary 3-5 Schedule for BISD First Week**

- The schedule for On-Campus is as follows:
  - 3rd Grade
    - On campus Wednesday
    - Virtual Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
  - 4th Grade
    - On- campus Thursday
    - Virtual Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday Friday
  - 5th Grade
    - On campus Thursday
    - Virtual Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday



#### MEET THE TEACHER



- Virtual "Meet the Teacher" will be held by each classroom teacher on Thursday, August 27, 2020.
- Families will receive email communication from your child's teacher prior to August 27th. This email will include a pre-recorded "welcome video", classroom virtual tour, and an opportunity for parents to schedule a 15 minute "Meet The Teacher" virtual conference to take place on Thursday, August 27th.



### ARRIVAL



- Our staff members will greet our Frazier Bears into the building beginning at 7:15am.
- All students ages 10 years and older, and staff members will be required to wear a face covering. Family members who walk students to the front should also be wear a face covering.

#### Grade Level Arrival Locations:

- PreK, FLS, PDLC, and SLC students and siblings will enter through the cafeteria doors.
- Kindergarten-1st Grade car riders, walkers, and bike riders enter through the gym doors.
- 2nd-5th Grade car riders, walkers, and bike riders enter through our front main doors.

### **ARRIVAL**



- Upon arrival in our car rider lane, students will need to be ready and prepared to exit cars without school assistance.
- Staff members will monitor student arrival and ensure social distance at designated spots at doors and in hallways.
- Kindergarten students will enter through the gym door where their teachers will be awaiting them.
- 1st 5th graders will report directly to their classroom areas.



#### **ARRIVAL**



- If a student chooses to eat breakfast upon arrival, staff will monitor students and ensure social distancing.
- During breakfast, students will pick up "grab and go" breakfast in the cafeteria upon arrival and take it to their classroom or eat in a designated area that allows for social distancing.
- Students will be encouraged to bring water bottles to school for their personal use.
- Students are also encouraged to bring healthy, nut-free snacks in their backpacks.



#### DISMISSAL



- Grade level teachers will escort the following student groups to their dismissal location:
  - Walkers/ Bike Riders will exit through the main entrance.
    - Teachers will maintain a daily check off list of walkers/bikers and monitor social distancing.
    - Teachers/ staff members will escort students off campus where parents will connect with their students. (West Bend and Cedar Ridge)
  - **Bus Riders/ Daycare** will exit through our cafeteria doors:
    - Students will socially distance/ wear masks throughout the cafeteria by bus/ daycare
    - Staff members will monitor students/ ensure social distancing.



### DISMISSAL



- Car Riders will exit through our main entrance.
  - Grade level teachers on duty:
    - Walk students to their designated locations
    - Monitor students and ensure social distancing
    - Dismiss students to their car loading zone when their name is called.
  - o **PK**, **FLS**, **PDLC** students/siblings will wait in the cafeteria for dismissal.
  - Kindergarten, 1st grade car riders will wait in the gym to wait for their name to be called and exit from the gym.
  - 2nd-5th car riders:
    - 2nd grade: our main center hallway
    - 3rd grade: side rotations hallway
    - 4th grade: library
    - 5th grade: side nurse's office/library hallway



#### **DISMISSAL**



#### Car Riders continued:

- Staff members will be located through our main hallways directing students to the front door.
- As students arrive outside for car loading, staff members will direct students to their car loading zone along our porch/ sidewalk.
- Car line staff members will announce when each zone may load their car.
- Staff members will be wearing gloves to help our little Frazier Bears open doors.

#### After School Program (ASP):

- ASP students will exit their classrooms and socially distance in the K/1 hallway.
- ASP staff members will maintain a check-in list.



#### LUNCH



- In order to maintain social distancing, only one grade level will eat lunch in the cafeteria, at a time.
- Staff members will ensure social distancing while in line and at tables.
- Students will sit three to a table.
- Students with food allergies will enjoy lunch at a separate table.
- In order to maintain the health and safety of our students and staff, lunch visitors will not be able to eat lunch with their student.
- Students who purchase their lunch will be assisted by cafeteria staff as they select their food choices to ensure minimal student contact.
- Parents are encouraged to make prepayments on students' accounts using <u>Meal Payment</u>, to avoid cash transactions during meal service.

## LUNCH



- Our campus plans include our Frazier Bears eating lunch in the cafeteria as well as eating lunch in the classroom or other designated areas.
  - Our Kindergarten-3rd grade students will eat lunch in the cafeteria.
  - Our Pre-K and PDLC students will eat in our science lab.
  - Our 4th-5th students will eat in non-traditional areas to create social distancing, such as, classroom, courtyard, science lab, outside areas (weather permitting).
- Cafeteria tables and high touch areas will be sanitized after each lunch period.



#### **RECESS**



- All students and staff will be required to use hand sanitizer before entering the playground and upon exiting the playground.
- Students will go outside to enjoy recess, but classrooms will be assigned to play area zones to keep cohorts of students together.
- All grade level teachers will monitor recess duty.
- Classroom teachers will rotate to each play area zone through the week.
  - Our recess zones include: playground, basketball/ hard top, grassy fields



#### WALKING AROUND FRAZIER



- Our Frazier Bears are encouraged to wear masks or face shields that cover their mouth and nose during transitions and in common areas.
- Staff members will assist during transitions to monitor social distancing.
- One-way traffic is established throughout campus corridors to support social distancing and reduce face-to-face interactions.
- When it is not possible for one-way hallways, students should stay to the far right side of the corridor to reduce the possibility of contact.
- Signage will be displayed throughout our campus as a reminder to practice social distancing.
- Each student will maintain a distance of 3 floor tile lengths to ensure social distancing.



#### **RESTROOMS**



- Teachers will have procedures in their classroom to ensure that only one student is out at a time for a restroom break.
- For whole group restroom breaks, grade levels and classrooms will stagger restroom times and monitor and ensure health and safety protocols are followed.
  - No more than 2 students in a restroom at one time.
  - No more than 1 student at a handwashing station at one time.



# SCHOOL SUPPLIES AND STANDARDIZED DRESS



- Students in both online and in-person classes will be encouraged to have basic school supplies inside a pencil box or zipper pouch.
- Students will need the following items:
  - Pencils
  - Crayons
  - Glue
  - Scissors
  - Paper
  - Markers
- For the 2020-2021 school year, all standardized dress requirements have been waived.
   Please follow the BISD Student Dress Code.
